Jan 1 Ad went to Delta Elton & Miss. Samet & Bessie were with him they are going to Wats fine day

2 very stormy day snow and wind heavy drifts
Ad came home from Delta this afternoon

3 Still storming Ad went to gunnysage with a gun no traveling on the roads they are drifted

4 Still storming Wallace went for a load of wood & to bring Malcom home but he came home yesterday Wallace was from 11 o'clock till dark getting back there is no travel on the roads he was the only one

5 Rev W Oby preached this morning & W Gorret at night Ad took W Oby to Fairfax in the afternoon

6 Went with W Oby to see Mr Darling he is very poorly he has taken gonorrhea in his little toe James Mcullen took us Ad took Jennie to Farmersville she is going to the high school there the roads is very bad Malcom is drawing dung heap to day into the garden fine day

7 Ad Wallace & Malcom went to the 6 Can Ad brought a load of wood here & attended the annual school meeting W W Thompson was put in trustee instead of Lattimer stormy day

8 Ad drew 2 loads of wood brought here

9 Ad do 1 he left it here Rob Beathys came up with a snow toads stayed all night at Ad's

10 Ad drew 2 loads of wood left here took home

11 Rev W Oby preached a missionary sermon we had no minister

12 Malcom drew 2 loads of wood he left 1 here took the other to the road cut some wood for me & had a load coal

13 Malcom drew 2 loads of wood left 1 here took 1 to the road Ad went to Delta as a witness for Billie

14 Malcom drew 1 load of wood he left 1 here cold day Ad got home in the night very stormy wind & snow this morning Malcom drew 1 load of wood here

15 Malcom drew 1 load here & 1 to the road

16 Malcom drew 1 load here then he sawed some wood for me in the wood shed fine day but cold
17 Rev W Oby preached for us this morning W Gorret at night storm last night
