to night 15th Windy Drawing wood in
the Sugar Bush Leander came through
the night about 2 o'clock a Broom 16th Sea
16th Freeze hard Last night Very Fine to Day
Leander shot 4 Ducks Fernandez crossed
got 2 Scotch Papers from Dan & W
to night an Eclipse to night on the Moon
and a change on the Moon 17th
Fine & Wind Fixed up a Small Box
of Ducks for Dan Leander crossed
with the Box to Kaggartys to go
in the Morning Mary Ann here
She is married to Jo Mitchell the
Indian got oil and Whitewash bars

James Cameron Island 18th Dec 1899
Calm a very very Fine Day Sun
very hot Boys to Ross Island for Ducks
Went for Eels got 11 Taking the Boards
out of the Granery to the new house
Randolph here Frank Saplant Raising
some of the sunken Boats to Day I hear
John Hamilton Bulchering to Day
19th Raining West Wind Fixed a Peice to
the spear pole to make it longer no Fish
no Ducks no Mink to Day Windy to night
Wrote a Letter Daled the 21st with 25 -
cents in it to Douglas & Company
Napanele Ontario 20 Fine Windy West
Fernandez went to Saucaster with the crons
of the Mill no Ducks sawed a part of
an ash Log Windy to night Last Day of
the Fall sent off the Letter to Saucaster & C
for Napanele Fernandez did not come tonight
yet St Thomas Day the Shortest Day
in the year Gordon here Fernandez came
Leander to Summers town Got 3 Letters
1 from Dan 1 from John Cameron 1 from A. M. at the
22nd Fine East Wind took over the Rest
of the Boards out of the Granery
