and Mr Brown preached to united congregation

church. St Andrews coll 5 ds

Monday

Cloudy and sunny. Three builders up all day
got gable end nearly finished. Willie
went down in A M got at Moffatts 25 scotting
2 x 4 12 ft for rafters also 9 bushels lime @ 60c a bag.
in P M he ploughed barley stubble also end in No 7 W.
Perringlow horses I found the same out in A M.
I cut rafters in P M for kitchen put up gable ends.
7 after up in P M pulling round and ploughs.

Tuesday

Fine sunny day. Willie went down town
got at Nichols on 45 50 ds nails 2 shovels 20 ds 40
got meat mills on 45 3 lbs Paid for Dunn \$1.00 same.
He then ploughed rest of day No 7 end brought in barley seedings
Three builders here all day finished kitchen & worked
at kitchen put up rafters etc. Mrs Mallan here for dinner.

Wednesday

Fine sunny warm day. Willie down town
in A M got tools filled on 45 at Reid's Woods meat mills
I fared out rest of No 7 W in A M. In P M I sheathed
kitchen and Willie ploughed No 7 & horses

Thursday

Raining more or less all A M heavy at
times fine in P M. I went down in buggy
