Cloudy and sunny. Three builders up all day got gable end nearly finished of Kiltom. Willie went down in A.M. got at Moffatts 25 acounting 2x4 12ft for rafters also 9 bushels lime @ 60s on a/c. in P.M. he ploughed barley stubble also and in No 7 W. Perinpton 4 horses I ferred the same out in A.M. I cut rafters in P.M. for Kiltom put up gable end. 7 other up in P.M. pulling round out stumps.

Fine sunny day. Willie went down town got at Nichol's on a/c 50 ds mails 2 shovs 70 ds for 40 got meat Mills on a/c 3 lbs Paid for Dinner 1.00 sand. He then ploughed rest of day No 7 and brought in barley reaping. Three builders here all day finished Kiltom I worked at Kiltom put up rafters etc. Mrs. Mitchell here for dinner.

Wednesday

Fine sunny warm day. Willie down town in A.M. got tools filled on a/c at Reid's 100 ds meat Mills I ferred out rest of No 7 W in A.M. In P.M. I sheathed Kiltom and were ploughed No 7 4 horses

Thursday

Raining more or less all A.M. bright times fine in P.M. I went down in buggy
