Giant pepper 2 ozs Pimento Pepper  
about 8 ozs our own hot pepper  
4 ozs Just + Best Tomatoes  
6 ozs John Baer "

6 ozs Copenhagen Cabbage in  
forty four sashes -  
cold last night but clear  
+ frosty today.

Feb 9th milder today east wind  
bright + clear fine hotbed weather

Feb 10th East. winds + mild  
Cabbage up already sowed on  
Feb 7th, trimming old orchard.

Feb 11th. cold east wind fixing  
sash in the barn -

Feb 12th Sunday. motored to Ham.  
had dinner at Mrs Barlow's + tea  
at Lillian's mother's weather fine  
just like April.

Feb 13th Fine, trimming trees.
