- Tue May 11. Fine and bright. but cold north wind terrific dust
- Wed May 12. Fine a little warmer. Aunt M. painted Radiators. Aunt N and I put in Beans. Annie & I picking flowers in eve
- Thur May 13. Fine but dull and cold. Aunt M. and I at Grave yard.
- Fri May 14. Fine but cool. I called at Maudley's. Mary Watson called
- Sat May 15. Fine day. north wind and blowing dust all week. I went to Lucy Knight's funeral. called at J. Griffiths Annie here in eve
- Sun May 16. Fine much warmer. Aunt N. at church. all at evening Church
- Mon May 17. Fine quite warm. Range out. first. painted sink and varnished wood work. Aunt N. took plate to Dentist. meals downstairs washed woolen blankets and our quilt.
