Raining and thawing A.M. sunny most P.M. thawed a lot. We put load pea straw on long slaps backed it - to sheep house put load in and door then went to other barn brought over load hay. P.M. Willie drove Mary to Dix and Sam M. Kees collecting for B.S. Kate in cutter. I fixed swinging trough in pig pen N. West one raised door of it higher than rest & large pigs in that pen and six smaller ones where they were. Willie chopped some.

Mr Rennie Jr (on D Mills farm) and Mr Collins in A.M. trying to sell us fertilizer. His Phosphoric acid was worth \$3.00 per ton 12% P. Acid. 14% worth \$25.00 per ton 70 B Fergus mixed fertilizer \$29.00 per ton 2 Nitrogen 8 Phos acid.

Thawing all day cloudy and raining some 135 A.M. mostly sunny P.M. sleighing gone. We chopped some and put up chop for pigs A.M. P.M. I drove Mary home Kate in cutter. I went to Browns sale (old Mills property) Mary stayed down. Willie went down at night got at Fergus Electrical Supply store battery for flash light 35 ds. Exceedingly windy to-night and a little frosty.
