James Lyons in in morning got 65 tils \$1.30. We did inside work to-day clean young cattle stable put gate on stall to make box stall for cold lean from. first cattle stall next roosters to cow pen. Jennie Rogerson in for Mrs Campbell's stakings. Girls over at Bowleys PM to see remains of Mrs Black.

I made frame and hung it to window in pig pen to keep pigs from jumping up and breaking glass out of the window. We put two pane glass in which they had broken Willie helped Bill change furnace pipes to go through hall. I went and Mary went to Mrs Black's (Mrs Fred Bowley aunt) funeral PM. Mary got honey and rice at Stubs on sp of chickens. We uncovered hay and put load straw top/pipes. Mary stayed down.
