- Sat Mar 4. Much colder. roads frozen rough. Mary Chapman and Jemima Eddy called. I went to Lenten Service.
- Sun Mar 5. Fine and colder. Willie called. milder and rain in eve.
- Mon Mar 6. Very muddy and mild until evening then colder and freezing. Aunt Nellie up. Mrs Davidson called she and I at eve church.
- Tue Mar 7. Fine and mild roads terribly cut. Aunt Nellie not so well at night. I went for medicine in eve.
