

Croton June 1888

Wed Jun 20<sup>th</sup> clear and hot. 95 deg in the shade. I finished hoeing the lower field and commenced to hoe the little patches by the house. Walter was cultivating part of the day.

Thu Jun 21<sup>st</sup> cloudy in the morning and evening thunder but no rain here. a very hot day. 98 deg in the shade. we finished hoeing the corn the first time over commenced to hoe the carrots.

Fri Jun 22<sup>nd</sup> clear and very hot. we were hoeing sowed corn & carrots. I was cutting Canada thistles in the oats.

Sat Jun 23<sup>rd</sup> cloudy most of the and sultry, a thunder shower last night. we were drilling turnips and hoeing potatoes most of the day.

Sun Jun 24<sup>th</sup> cloudy and wet in the fore noon after noon clear sultry. very close & hot. was not to Church to day.

Mon Jun 25<sup>th</sup> cloudy and showers. we were hoeing potatoes. we finished hoeing the first time over.

Tue Jun 26<sup>th</sup> clear part of the day and pleasant. quite cool this evening. I was cutting thistles in the fore noon after noon was cutting weeds out of sowed corn. Walter commenced to cultivate corn the second time.

Wed Jun 27<sup>th</sup> cloudy high wind from the east and cool. commencing to rain. I was mowing thistles. Walter cultivating corn.

Thu Jun 28<sup>th</sup> cloudy rain last night and this fore noon. was not doing much to day went to Croton and paid my blacksmith bill and received for hay I sold S. <sup>Hay</sup> Phillips & L. Phillips and W. Maguire. after noon was cutting thistles awhile.
