- 12th Saved wood for Pycrofts. ^{11th} Betsy came to help for days.
- 18th Finished drawing in corn stalks from the field.
- 20th Went to the bush and brought home the sap. Finished after having made about a gale of Syrup.
- 21st Mike Sabotie came to work for 8 mos.
- 23rd Started to roll meadows and to cultivate.
- 25th Took the car to town for the first time. Edith went to Clarence.
- 28th Grandma Lee died after a lingering sickness of two mos. or more.
- 28th Finished sowing oats in north hill field.
- 30th Went to Grandma Lee's Funeral, a real cold day.
- May 2nd Finished sowing mixed grain in south east corner field.
- 4th Went to Brantford and Echo place with the car.
