- 23 Dull and thawing after dark began to rain
- 24 Was raining when I got up but cleared up fine. In the afternoon it was bright & sun shiny. Had three calls from ladies, 1st Mrs Barrell, 2d Annie Campbell, 3d and last Mrs Arthur Ross, who remained to tea I got at J. A's 2 cans of apples 25cts. Pa and boys began to split and put away wood
- 25 Very fine day. but cold wind I think Africa is boiling today. Pa got Dyers offset to the summons
- 26 Fine day. Pa went to Cornwall to see a lawyer, and Far went to Toronto This afternoon Jimmie went to a sale at W. McGregor's K Road Africa bought about 2 pairs of "dracle" Pa got \$50⁰⁰ from H. B. interest of some money
- 27 Pa and boys filed the wood
- 28 Fine day much warmer. I think the crop will run well. Pa paid his account at Willis \$8 and at Tillous \$3⁰⁰. Mrs Ross spent the evening with us. Marion was at Sniders to tea Aunt was not well yesterday but is better today. Birdie gave me a nice Bible today cost about 2⁵⁰
- 29 Not many in church. Fine day roads bad, good sugar weather
30. Was up early this morning. Murdy went to Alexandria. Splendid sugar day Pa had headache
