- June 1 Worked in the garden planted cucumber & tomatoes
- 2 Gandy went to Storble rack for a load of shingles for Mr Thompson
- 3 Gandy went for another load for Mr Thompson
- 4 the Rev Mr Cochran preached in the forenoon and the Rev Mr Wallace in the afternoon
- 5 Jare went to Brackville to meet Nat to go to Paltown & fix <sup>or work</sup> some of the apple trees
- 6 I worked at a railroad at Mr Corneils in the afternoon
- 7 went to Storble rack got 275 lb of Barley dust & 251 feet of plank for a drain ~~from~~ the cellar & ditch <sup>to</sup> & Gandy made 16 bunks of pine at the north <sup>side</sup>
- 8 fixed the plank for the ditch and put them in & covered them & filled around the well very dry weather Gandy went to Jonanaguee Dixie came home from Brackville Nat & Jare went to Toronto last night Water going to Rio River Jare is going on the Pacific Railroad
- 9 I helped P floor this forenoon Gandy began to roll and rolled the old horse poster
- 10 fixed some of the apple trees in the forenoon attended a case of Silling liquor with license approved
- rain The decision for a month or a little rain today
- 11 no meeting today Mr Cochran went to Jonanaguee Mr Barren is very sick
- 12 Gandy went to Brackville for Mr Corneils Buggies Jare left it there when he went to Ottawa Ad went to Young to see Gramman & Deable before he went away <sup>to</sup> J. Stark & <sup>to</sup> finished working the apple trees
- 13 Rab. Armstrong <sup>came</sup> home with Ad last night Ad went away on the express today Mr Farley's son went with him they are going to Fort Garry heavy rain <sup>last night</sup>
- rain 14 worked on the roads I am path master showing in the afternoon fine growing time
- 15 went to the funeral of John Jones wife there was 43 turns & a number walking the Rev Mr Caswell preached she was buried at the Dulemver schoolhouse
