 Frost last night fine sunny day windy in P.M. Willie cultivated and harrowed No 7 W. Mary down in P.M. sold to Fort 2 doz eggs 24^{cts} bought groceries 30^{cts}
 Father and mother came up with her in evening planted some horse chestnuts maples and an elm small ones 3 lambs yesterday and 5 to-day.

25 Tuesday
 Frost last night pretty hard. fine sunny warm day. We brought over load hay from other team in morning. Then I seeded in No 7 W 4 or five acres Waverley next Banner seeded same down with Mammoth, Red and black clover and timothy. 12 lbs mixture 2 1/2 bushels hats to acre. Willie went over sowed land with Lucy in weeder. Girls down town in P.M. got at Steels cellars & butter 35 sold 4 lbs butter 80.
 Gave mother for rooster 25 Father birthday present 100 yesterday
 Girls called on Mrs Magwood in P.M.
 We have 28 lambs to date
