July 19 continued Monday forward 892 85 83871  
 corn and helping with hay. I scuffled turnips A.M. Willi cut some more hay No. 1. Mand ran away with mader smashed it to pieces. I went to station for wire paid freight on it \$1.05 brought 3 lbs balled up in buggie L. Taylor brought rails up in truck I got at Hartman's on a/c meat 55 at Arskings on a/c sugar \$1.00 P.M. we took in what was cut Saturday 5 or 6 loads Willi cut some more after tea W.L. raked with Lucy. Georgina Spark came in P.M. stayed all night.

## Tuesday

Fine sunny day warm. I finished scuffling turnips in the A.M. Willi finished cutting No. 1 hay. Willi sorted up all day doing corn & hay. We got 8 loads hay in P.M. all raked up also raked some as it looked like rain.

Annie & Koch up for dinner and tea. I awoke in evening. Mrs. Lass over at night for milk 55. Georgina Spark went to Toronto to-day going back to Middlesex

## Wednesday

Raining this morning and some in A.M. some sunshine in P.M. We took wire and utensils down home took down board fence top of lot put in anchor post and stretched 10 wires came back after six took in load hay and raked up rest of No. 1.

## Thursday

Cloudy all day raining at times pretty heavy at noon. I went down A.M. wore the fur coat we strong yesterday. Aunt Lass came in stage Willi got new bolt at Reids hardware in full 1.25 got at Boys big feed 1.25 also paint June 24th 3.00 sold 12 dz eggs @ 19/2.25 gave mother \$1.05.
