July 19 continued Monday Forward

 Mand ran away with wheel smashed it
 to pieces. I went to station for wire paid
 freight on it \$1.05 brought 3 bps balled up in
 buggy L. Taylor brought coils up in his rack
 I got at Hartman's and meat 55 at Muskings
 on of sugar \$1.00 P M we took in what
 was out Saturday 5 or 6 loads with out some
 more after tea W. L. raked with Lucy. Georgina
 Spark came in P M stayed all night.

Fine sunny day warm. I finished scuffling
 turnips 2nd time 9 AM with finished cutting No 1
 hay. with Lister up all day doing corn & hay.
 We got 8 loads hay in P M all raked up also
 coaled some as it looked like rain.
 Annie Skoock up for Dinner and tea. Father up
 in evening. Mrs Larr over at night for milk 55
 Georgina Spark went to Toronto to-day going back to Milltown

Raining this morning and some in AM some
 sunshine in P M. We took wire and utensils
 down home took down board fence top of lot put in
 anchor post and stretched 10 wires came back after we
 took in load hay and coaled up rest of No 1.

Thursday

Cloudy all day raining at times pretty heavy at noon. I went
 down AM wore the fence at home we string yesterday. Aunt Carrie came on stage
 with got new toll at Rids friend's in full 4.25 got at Bays big feed 4.25 also paid June 24 of 3.00
 sold 12 doz eggs @ 1.00 = 12.00 gave mother \$1.05.
