- Fri Feb 4th cloudy part of the day and cool.
- Sat Mar 5th cloudy and soft. sleighing about done. Walter brought part of his Intrest money on his mortgage.
- Sun Mar 6th cloudy and wet Mary Paul and Logan Mead was here this evening
