1874

Went on horseback to S. School this morning, the heavy rain of last night has made it very muddy. Inpt. abs. See pres. lesson, Mark VII, 24 to 30, "The Syro-phoenician mother". At Brampton W.M. S. School this afternoon and choir practice at 4 P.M. Heard Rev W.B. Burns preach at 6 o'clock, text, John III, 3rd verse

MONDAY 21

Threshing at Mr. Gabry Heath's today. Walked to Brampton this evening and went with W.M. Choir over to Springbrook to sing at a S.S. Tea meeting. Had a very pleasant time, both at the meeting and the moon-light drive, the speakers were Revs James Pringle and J. Arque. Got home at midnight.

TUESDAY 22

1874

Threshing today at Mr. Robert Smith's. Have spent a whole week at threshing, about tired of the job now and especially of the dust. Father and Vinny went to Toronto this morn by train to attend the Exhibition. Weather is cool and pleasant. Grain market is getting lively wheat at a low figure \$1.00 per bush barley at 94¢

WEDNESDAY 23

Donned my good clothes at 10 A.M. and walked to Brampton took G.I.R. train at 12 o'clock for Toronto to attend Provincial Exhibition. Took tea and staid all night at Aunt Lizzie's. Spent evening at Metropolitan W.M. Church hearing a lecture by Rev Gervase Smith of England on "The trial of the seven bishops"
