John Milton Camerons  
Birth Day 1876 W W Fine sap  
not running well Boiled 20 pails  
made 4 gallons split since  
last night 3 gallons took 4 to the  
House Randolph crossed to the  
K. Office Bought Bottling Spruce  
Gum 25 Rivers Sale to Day  
about 165 Tapt now 2<sup>nd</sup> Good Wind  
I went to Hamlet's & Wind Ice  
Gib got some Red Peppers Got  
a Gazette from James High  
Got the Picture from Toronto  
made 1 1/2 gallons to Day Lewis  
children here for milk Lewis  
wife a Daughter yesterday 28<sup>th</sup>  
in the Bush Fine E Wind Seander  
crossed to Summerstown Got salt Tea  
10 lb 20 Tare 5 Salmon River open  
crossing Summerstown Road a  
cutter went up passed here  
Lots of Ducks and Wild Geese  
Robins came 29<sup>th</sup> Fine they  
2 girls went to Lewis Brought  
some Mollasses to them Boiling  
in the Bush Dan spunk here  
Bill Morris went Down passed  
with a Horse Easter Sunday  
Killed a snake

Mr James Cameron Island 30<sup>th</sup> of March 1891  
E Wind sap running well Lewis  
Boy here for milk Made Mollasses  
31<sup>st</sup> E Wind Peeling stove wood  
The Ice opened at Francis  
Island on the North side of this  
Isle have also 20 gallons of syrup  
to make sugar tomorrow  
1<sup>st</sup> of April all Fools Day  
Ice opened out at the Point Lewis  
2 children here for milk they  
went up to the Sugar Bush  
made 2 Batches to Day for the  
first we made 117 lb Frogs  
commenced E Wind Fine few Drops  
of Rain 2<sup>nd</sup> Fine E W Made 2  
Batches to Day 127 lb Ice opening  
Lots of Wild Geese and Ducks Peeling  
stove wood a good Deal of shooting  
on the South side Hay all done on the  
East side of the Barn 3<sup>rd</sup> Snowing  
Ice Jamming Boys put out Phillips  
Bun went to Little Island went to  
the Pitt Point made about 6 lb sugar in  
small cakes 4<sup>th</sup> West Wind Fine sap  
Running cleaned the troughs and Buckets  
Boiling in the Bush Boys shot a Duck  
at the Little Island Ice Jamming
