**Early Sign of Pott's Disease,**

Angelescu has noticed that caries of the spine generally begins in the anterior segment, and consequently that traction on the anterior longitudinal ligaments is painful in these cases even where there is nothing else to suggest the vertebral process. He has the patient lie on the back and arch the body, resting only on the back of the head and the heels. This position induces pain in the diseased area or the pain is so severe that the patient is unable to assume this attitude.—*Exch.*
