 Fixing the Blocks on the Bob-sleighs  
 the Owl Dead at the Shanty Frosty  
 24<sup>th</sup> Charlie Supper's Birth Day  
 Fine & Wind Fixing the shafts  
 Went to the Surgeon Island  
 cut some stakes Drew 6 of the  
 Basswood Logs to the Grove Drew  
 a Load of Wood Fixing warmer  
 commenced to snow to night  
 25<sup>th</sup> Robie Burr's Birth Day Fine  
 Warm & Wind snowing Wind changed to  
 West 2 stars Pretty close together this  
 some time cut 2 Poles for shafts  
 Working at them to night 26<sup>th</sup> & Wind  
 kind of soft Drew some Wood

Mr Mills Miller on Island 27<sup>th</sup> of January  
 Fine Frosty Windy sawing stove wood  
 split 2 Logs for Rails Fine to night  
 28<sup>th</sup> Stormy & Wind Drifting the Harness  
 and cables did not go to Drink to Day  
 took in the Bottom of the Marsh Hay  
 stack cut some stove wood 29<sup>th</sup> W.W.  
 cutting stove wood went to ~~at the~~  
 29<sup>th</sup> Windy the 2 girls went to Lewis's  
 table for ~~Martha to Hamilton~~  
 30<sup>th</sup> Frosty Fine No Day Morris  
 came down from Mr Ponds  
 sawing stove wood 31<sup>st</sup> & Wind  
 a very fine Day the girls went to  
 Summers town took the Horse  
 and cutter took 8 lb of Butter  
 18 cents a lb 1.44 Bought of Summers  
 10 yds of goods a Dollar lining 1/2 yd of Calico  
 Thread went up to the camp to look  
 at them Bolts 1<sup>st</sup> of February & Wind  
 Drifting Windy Leander Anne Mary Morris  
 Went down on the ice to Lancaster Bought  
 of Mr Gleniva Table 750 Dollars
