 to Day at Potatoes and Beans Seen Wild Geese  
 8<sup>th</sup> Julia Summers Married to Day Windy  
 the wife went off but we got him at Potatoes  
 speaking to Henry Boselle and Lewis Bird  
 the Fisherman went off got a stick of Bass 1000  
 for the stable 9<sup>th</sup> at the West stable put a  
 stick on the top and covered it with straw  
 hay at Potatoes 10<sup>th</sup> High Wind Mr. Misters  
 Birth Day 1844 Fine Windy Taking up Potatoes  
 Shelling Beans (Randolph to Summers town  
 11<sup>th</sup> Windy 2 Wind (Koured some 12<sup>th</sup> E Wind  
 Ploughed up the Last Rows of the Potatoes and  
 taking up Potatoes the Potatoes Rotting Bad  
 no crop at all of them 13<sup>th</sup> E Wind at the  
 Potatoes and Beans L. by heated Put in some  
 Potatoes to Day 14<sup>th</sup> High E Wind Raining Thunder  
 and Lightning Fine changed to West Wind shot  
 2 Ducks Randolph shot one of them Mr  
 Joseph Duckett here sold him wood for  
 10 Dollars she will buy the Manure of  
 I take 65 But I want 100 That  
 a Flask I told him I would split the  
 Difference That would be 82.50 Hunters  
 from ogdensburgh to Charles Island sent  
 with the Fishermen for another of the Flask  
 shirts and a pair of Leather mits 15  
 francs here and a Boat Load of Raftmen took  
 the oak gave only 2 Dollars sent a line to  
 Mr M Arthur Francis left his Canoe here Killed one  
 of the sheep and she is good 16<sup>th</sup> So Duck  
 came for the wood Mr. M. Lemmon gave me 35  
 Down the other <sup>Warner Boat as running</sup> when he takes it away in the  
 Winter Fine Day 17<sup>th</sup> took all the wood got 8 Dollars  
 to Day got a Suit of Flannel from Montreal Fine  
 Randolph to Summers town Bought 2 Bolls RR 50  
 Watch 2 Cakes 2

Mr James Connor, Rand 18<sup>th</sup> October  
 at Luke's Bay Fine 18<sup>th</sup> Houghing Potato ground  
 all the Potatoes in Fine the Eagle Broke his Nose  
 and Flew to the clear Place in the Wishes  
 gained a Paul of Beans Rained some 20<sup>th</sup> South Wind  
 Went around the Island found a small little Bag  
 not knowing what was in it I went Down  
 for Narcise the Fisherman before I would open  
 it in case it might be something so we  
 went over where it was we opened and  
 Behold you it was 7 Beautiful purple  
 Wind high Rained this Evening took in the  
 east of the Beans Fanned a Spail of them  
 Preparing the grapes not much this year The  
 Alexandra went Down Made a few Pliers of  
 tobacco 21<sup>st</sup> Hamingall Day W Wind 22<sup>nd</sup> Fine Evening Wood  
 crushed the Beans 23<sup>rd</sup> Livinia Birth Day 1868 Raining Fine  
 Wind Randolph went to seine with Narcise got 12 suckers for  
 his share crossed to Summerstown gave John Summers  
 Dollars to my account got a Receipt Bought a Patter for  
 pool of Thread 5 paid this Bought of Buchanan 100 of Flour  
 50 Thread 6 cents Bought 1 lb of Tea for Hamiltons 40  
 bought of Mr Ward 1 pan of Bread for Narcise 22 and  
 cow eat  $\frac{1}{2}$  and I Bought another 3 11 cents Munkha  
 Summers at Hamiltons or Mrs Tutchie Heard Maggie  
 back Died of smallpox in the Hospital got some  
 apples I Hamilton and Mr W. Pherson at Lighthouse  
 the Lighthouse Water very high with the Rain heard  
 and is to be Hung on the 10<sup>th</sup> of Nov 2 Wind  
 24<sup>th</sup> Our 61<sup>st</sup> Birth Day 73 andling East end of  
 the House Fine W Wind 25 Rained Birth Day  
 Fine Warm Day 26 Went to Fort Covington 4 Tennets of Butter  
 attled with Mr Long Dundee 7 96 Bought of J H 2 Dg Thous Forks 55  
 Dec 28 Calico 50 Thread 3 Bullows 10 Lining 18 Lining 15 Dref. 75 cloth  
 7 4 41 Bought of M<sup>o</sup> to 2 Tennets 40 2 Bapers of soda 14 sugar 70  
 at 35 cash 4 cash 3 owes 90 Bought of Mr Long shawl 3 75 owl  
 at 20 starch 7 Tea-spoons 50 sugar 35 on credit (Jan 25 paid)  
 5 Dollars owe
