692 Cold chilly day cloudy, drizzling P.M. We cultivated in No 3 & also No 4. I mended roller also dropped pig & cow. Willie drove up to Blacks after dinner got 196 lbs peas for seed \$5.00 I sowed them P.M. Eastland from E fence also one width of seeds & that rest our own which were buggy house got Blacks. after sowing the peas Willie rolled and I harrowed. Willie drove Mary down P.M. as they were going down the line of Blacks cattle began run their auto into telephone post below Pikes corner smashed the post broke auto. Mary got at Phillips Eden order 1340 cents 12¢ dry goods Steub \$1.15 goods Russell on off 3:22
