1. Friday, Munroy mason here. Showery all day. To 1 pkl force 15-
2. Jimmie got the cow Libby Campbell, this morning with a new he calf. took them home in evening, killed the calf & skinned it then buried it. Very heavy rain last night some showers today. John M. Grammer 2d cow was buried today at 3d Con Cemetery. Pa went with Jack Sullivan. Bobie Demoulin paid \$2.00 for rent. To steak & sausage 50. Pa & Birdie went to Groce. Pa had to go to Summerstown express office for a parcel of money from D. B. M. Luman. To 5 lb butter from factory.
3. Fine day Rev K. M. D. preached in afternoon a good sermon from 3d Chap Edge. dry bones
4. Birdie & Murdy went to spend the evening at D. Falkners. Washed in forenoon.
5. Murdy left for Moore Creek. took the Moccasin at Lancaster. Mrs Blackle and Eliza called. and are going after meeting calls to remain with us over night. Mrs D. Rogers called. she leaves for home on Thursday. Birdie has her Sunday school class this afternoon.
6. Fine day. Jimmie cut and gathered some hay yesterday, he is putting it in today and had Ed. Pidgeon help. at Pa got a load of sand from Perkins we have no more at barn this week, but Courie, who is churning by the 1000. Murdy got home in evening. Came by Moccasin Wilson brought the tennis fixings yesterday Ex. & 50. 15-65

7. Fine day Jimmie put in 4 loads of hay yesterday, is cutting today. Courie finished churning the cream & put on the straddle board. Pa paid him \$12.50. H. M. F. Janet in entry my off 25. Put at Willis 1 sink Kettle 25. 1 pkl force 15
8. Rained and drizzled all last night now 2 P.M. looks fair.
9. Fine bright day wind from W, rain about midnight of 6th. Got 5 lb butter from factory and report 50. To 2 bus soap 10. Boys put in loads of hay at the village farm. Mrs & M. Thomson and Mrs Angus Cobin of Lancaster called and remained to tea. Jimmie had Hugh Pidgeon and Ed Pidgeon. Saw Birdie 25 for part of ten's fee
10. Fine in morning. began to drizzle in afternoon heavy rain now. 11 P.M. To 5 lbs steak on Saturday
11. Monday. Windy in morning showery all afternoon I washed. Jimmie cutting
12. Packed in oven. fine day, high wind, good hay day. put in four loads of hay
13. Very fine day. Birdie went to the front carnival to visit Mrs & Miss Blacklock. She got a ride from Tupper to Summerstown Station. He was taking Miss Graham, to the evening Moccasin. Sold 3 doz eggs at Willis 45. Fine harvest day. Put at Willis 1 lb cream 40
14. 42 Sulphur 3 44 lb salts 2 2oz salt peter 3, molasses 18 1 gal coal oil 20 at Butcher 3 lb sausage 30 19qt blueberries from Kinzie M. Grammer 10
15. Looks like rain
16. To steak 36
