Friday forward 1926 71 293 39 828 04 32 95

Mostly cloudy a little breezy at times. not warm. I started to plow with Pench and Dan in small field below orchard when Dan lay down sick. Willie drove down in buggy with Lucy for M.F. adgor he gave Dan a ball and I took him to plow with again till noon. Willie drove M.F. down again got horses mended Wrens 25cts turnip seed stalks 75cts oatmeal 25cts 78s. he also took 12 lbs eggs to Remells \$4.60 on acq of goods. Willie dropped some d.M. P.M. we finished planting the orchard potatoes then spread rest of field pile No 2 7 1/2 loads also 2 loads from yard. M.H. up after school to see if we would need him to-morrow Mr Burger called to see us P.M. I sowed with grass seed and raked it in a piece of ~~heatland~~ on S. S. that was missed in seeding.

Saturday

Mostly fine sunny and breezy looked like rain P.M. breezy, not warm. M.H. all day. He disked and harrowed more land beyond corn land then I sowed further on it where rolled it.

647 PM we planted 18 rows potatoes with planter coming down No 2 sowed common corn to mark then combed to other marks than Early Knob & bottom and after row 3 to mark. 2d Boys to McDonald boy in P.M. Willie took cream down in morning

150 Mr Barber ran at night. Willie drove Mary down at night to stay he got at Phillips borax 11cts 2 toothbrushes 34cts varnish etc bushels 95cts. We paid McHale Hill in full balance 50cts. Shot lightning 20 00
