Thursday

Bright sunny day frosty not so cold as yesterday. We took loaded turnips down to Bette's 2 loads in Sam's sleigh to root house of frozen ones. We put load manure that was on sleigh in morning on pile in new orchard. I left our sleigh at Templins to get mended runner broken. Father up in P.M. We spread two loads manure on No 5

Friday

Sunny but not as bright as yesterday frosty. We put on load turnips brought it and load cells over from pit in a.m. I took load down after dinner but car was gone so brought it back again. We both took 4 bags to cell storage sold 3 @ 30 lbs @ 4.60 41.50 left one to get killed. Willie brought up dust from mill. Laid down in P.M. in cutter got at Amstons or ake buy floor add butter to Amstons 4 lbs @ 20 \$1.20 got greens \$1.20 got at stubs goods 20cts sent to y M.C.A \$1.00
