Colles's Fracture.

In reduction soon after the accident, without anesthesia, the most satisfactory method is a sudden, sharp jerk of the wrist administered by clasping one's fingers under the upper fragment, making pressure with the thumbs on the dorsum of the lower fragment, and abruptly pronating the hands.—Allen.

Was up this morning early & on my wheel in front of town clock at 3.40 A.M. It was too dark to start for home so I went down to Auntie Pops and stayed there for a while with her & Maud. When it got lighter I left Auntie Pops & started for home. I got home & had clothes changed ready for work at 5.20 A.M. No one was up when I got home. Equus's horse Nellie died to-day. Alta was over in afternoon but just for a few. Maud & I wheeled to town in the afternoon, got a letter from the dead letter office for to identify that there was a letter there from us which would be sent on for a 3 cent stamp. Visited Mr. Aude's for about 3/4 of an hour. Bought 2 lbs. vasoline for Polysmed. Was in to see Maud & Mc Jay for a while, saw Hattie Mc Lennan. Friday cleaned up all of the downstairs except kitchen had a regular house cleaning time.
