- 11 Sandy and I went to see my aunt Kate we remained for tea, we saw young W. Amun
- 12 Far & Robert left here at 10 A.M.
- 13 Cold and stormy. I washed today
- 14 Fine bright day, frosty. Mrs. Allen Grant Oge was here today. Anti Annie is better today 11 P.M. lovely moonlight
- 15 The concert in aid of the Institute took place tonight, five of us there - Jimmie Ran & myself. paid 75
- 16 Sick Collet paid rent 2. Oliver Collet paid rent ^{paper} 45
- 17 Rained today. I went to see David Taylor this afternoon Pa and boys went to Mrs J. Craig's (M.P.P.) funeral
- 18 It stormed all day, snow drifting in heaps
- 19 Big drifts. the mail did not go down today. Jimmie went to Lancaster to an Agricultural lecture got 25¢ of bread
- 20 A goodly number to Prayer Meeting. The collectors for the Bible Society were around on Tuesday. I gave 1.00
- 21 The meeting of the Bible Society took place in Heppelbach tonight. present. Rev. Geo. Watson Mathew M. Luman & Given. Collection \$51. Jimmie drew 2 loads of wood
- 22 Stormy & drifting, but not cold. Jimmie went for wood, but did not draw further than the Beaudette, left his load on the ice
- 23 Jimmie went with snow plough this morning
- 24 Cold day, not many out in the morning
- 25 Fine day, pretty cold.
- 26 Another fine day. Had a good Temple Meeting last night, 11 P.M. Am just home from spending the evening at J.A.'s, Given & wife were there and Pa & myself
- 27 Wednesday a very good prayer meeting. Far & I bought Dan McKizie's buggy & cutter for \$100 - I paid \$80. for buggy. Far 20. for cutter 80
It was on Monday 26 that they were bought. Jimmie done the buying 82.20
