Willie down town at night got at Mennis 10 cts monetraps 10 cts snaps at Armstrongs <sup>Canada</sup> cts. Mary got butter at Mrs Duanies 90 cts. Nellie Paulin and Euclie Blair came down in P.M. in the latter Pheaton stayed all night.
