Sat Aug 10th flying clouds and high Wind

Mon Aug 12th clear and hot cool last night
and this morning. I was sawing
and splitting wood part of the day
I settled with and paid Mrs Boyington
in full up to date.

Tue Aug 13th clear and hot and very dry
not doing any thing

Wed Aug 14th clear and hot. I was setting
in the house most of the day

Thu Aug 15th cloudy and hot. I went down
to the old place this after noon.
Mrs Gillman was here

Fri Aug 16th clear and hot in the middle of the
day. our old minister John Rysel
was here. not doing much myself

Sat Aug 17 cloudy and hot. not doing much

Sun Aug 18 cloudy a light shower
John Busons and wife was here

Mon Aug 19th cloudy part of the day and hot. I was
helping Brother Bilton take up the last
of his wheat and oats in the fore noon
after noon we went to Florence.

Tue Aug 20th cloudy some of the time and hot. I
went down to the old home. Dick was thrash-
ing grain not turning out very good.

Wed Aug 21st clear part of the day and hot. there
was thunder clouds. but no rain here
I was down where they were thrashing
at the old place in the fore noon not
doing much the rest of the day.

Thu Aug 22nd cloudy some of the time. and hot
not doing any thing.

Fri Aug 23rd cloudy and warm. thunder but
no rain here up to 6 P.M. not doing
much of any thing to day.

Sat Aug 24th clear and cool. I set in the house

Sun Aug 25 cloudy and cool

Mon Aug 26th cloudy and warm. I split stove
wood in the fore noon. after noon helping
Dick make a bridge at the old barn
