Fine some Drops of Rain here
at the Ditch finishing the
Stack of Marsh Hay 4th Fine
Gordon came had his new Suit
Leander and then went to Dundee
Gense went to Cornwall he
is fishing to night got a Sturgeon
Gordon went off 5th fine cutting
the oats down East put in
for the first oats 3 Loads today
Gense and I at the Ditch to
the fence cutting Brush
in the Oakfield 6th Wind
6th Randolph's B Day 1867
The Duke of Edinburgh B Day
Finished the oakfield (1844)
a Stack next the fence making
to Rain Thunder & Lightning most
awful High Wind kind of S West
blew Down a Fine Stack took
some of the other 2 Marsh Hay stacks

1895
James Cameron Island Aug 7th
Rained very hard this Morning
and some last night Mr
John Hall or (Hog) from
Hog Island here came in
from the storm of Rain
Lots of Trees Broken with
the Wind High Wind to Day
Thunder Lightning & fine
Windy blowing the oats in
the Upper field allowed the
pieces below the garden
one piece of oats in the upper
field not ripe cutting
hay at the Wet Place Mr Gense
went off Lots of Apples Down
Gth Gordon came had 1 Doz of
Journals 3 Boxes of matched Soap
Blacking Carpet shoes Yobacco
& used the stacks 10th
and Sussy went with Gordon
a very very warm Day the Wool
B D Summers 12 yds for Sussy
milling in oats.
