Fine day sunny and cloudy very warm in P.M. We worked turnip land made some more drills and sowed 32 we also scuffled potatoes. I made some more fence between us and Fords No 7 we pulled mustard in No 1 E after tea.

Tuesday

Fine sunny warm day cloudy in morning We worked more turnip land got in 28 more drills. I worked at 4th line fence No 7 in A.M. Girls down town in P.M. went to hospital to see Sophia got at Russells goods \$2.79 butter 55c on aft at Steals spoil 5c due bill

27

Wednesday

Fine sunny warm day. Willie at Road work to-day turn line earth harling etc got in 3 1/2 dgs I drilled in morning 14 more and sowed them with Jess then scuffled corn and garden. In P.M. I pulled mustard No 1. Mary down town in P.M. got at Harrison's pair shoes \$2.70. at Steals due bills \$1.75 for dress goods Jackson oranges 10c Phillips pair green 25c at Russells on aft

Thursday

Fine day cloudy at noon and rained few drops. We thinned mangols pulled mustard and finished sowing turnips 113 drills in all. Paid Mr Lass \$1.20 got from Byers for wine in full \$7.25. Bella brought up Sophia in evening. Mrs Inami and Lizzie M. Donald up in evening.
