- June 17 Humphrey Young plowed & dropped ^{it} furrowed out
the corn ground I was not off West to Gannops
with Isabella took David horse got my coat paid
planted a bushel of Indian corn. Ellen, Daniel & Isabella
went to Delta with the horses they took David horse
with them to park there.
- 18 planted ² bushel of western corn that is 1^{1/2} bushel
all in the field below the house it is for the cows.
- 19 drew dung to the pines spruces & cedar that I planted
along the lane.
- 20 went to Marble Rock for a load of hemlock lumber
for the roads break the axle of the wagon had
to leave the load near Cornet's cheese factory.
- 21 went through the potatoe corn & carrots in the
garden in the forenoon put on part of the stones
on the axle of the wagon in the afternoon
the Revd. Mr. Roberson preached in the forenoon
the Revd. Mr. W. H. in the afternoon warm day.
- 22 finished the wagon & went for the limestone
on the roads drew stones from Mr. Shimpson.
- 23 worked on the roads drawing gravel east of
St. Cornet's field.
- 24 worked on the roads half the day with the
horses that makes 4 days work for us
helped Isabella to pack her things in the afternoon.
- 25 went to Brockville with Isabella & things to get
them sent to Nebraska got the things to get
got home at 12 o'clock last night & Isabella
- 26 drew rails from the middle fence of the middle field
to put a fence at the foot of the come to keep the
horses in.
- 27 drew 13 loads of sand for Bush to lay
220 bushel of lime & 50 warm day
- 28 the Revd. Mr. W. H. preached in the school house
this morning. Went at 12 o'clock to the Tabernacle
church at 1 o'clock leaving 2nd 45 & 50 others
preach it & dedicated to the Lord.
