- June 17 Humphrey sprung plowed ^{drag} ^{to} ^{turn} ^{over} ^{the} ^{corn} ^{ground} ^{Swam} ^{at} ^{night} ^{Went} ^{to} ^{La} ^{Marque} ^{with} ^{Isabella} ^{took} ^{David} ^{horse} ^{got} ^{my} ^{coat} ^{paid}
- 18 planted a bushel of Mexican corn. Ellen, Jennet & Isabella went to Delta with the horses they took David horse with them to pasture there
- 19 planted 7 bushel of Mexican corn that is 1 1/2 bushel all in the field below the house it is for the cows
- 20 drew dung to the pine spruces & cedar that I plant along the lane
- 21 went to Marble Rock for a load of huckleb. lumber for the roads track the axle of the waggons had to leave the load near Cornels cheas factory
- 22 went through the potatoes corn & carrots in the garden in the forenoon put on part of the wax on the axle of the waggons in the afternoon
- 23 the Rev. W. Rabunson preached in the forenoon the Rev. W. Hies in the afternoon warm day
- 24 finished the waggon & went for the lumber & gravel on the roads drew stones from W. Humphreys
- 25 worked on the roads drawing gravel east of A Cornets field
- 26 worked on the roads half the day with the horses that makes 4 days work for us helped Isabella to pack her things in the afternoon
- 27 went to Brackville with Isabella's things to get them sent to Ketraska got the papers & tickets got home at 12 o'clock last night very warm
- 28 drew rails from the middle fence of the middle field To put a fence at the feet of the corn to keep the
- 29 drew 13 loads of sand for Shuck 190 bush 220 bush. 1 1/2. 20 lime 2. 50 warm day
- 30 the Rev. W. Hies preached in the school house this morning went at 12 o'clock to the Lutheran church where my love heard the Rev. W. Hies preach it & concluded to stay
