6th Fine cool & Wind finished
the nuts all in one Heap
took the Horse after them all
spread up on the Hill
7th Rained fast and to day Rained
making Blinds for Hunting
2 Boys here Kershaw and McTherel
Sold 2 Ducks 50 cents Finished
the Tumbler Quilt put up another
Quilt Fortunate Day 8th Windy Cool
splitting some Eggs got Turnips from
those Tenters Aligned some stones at the
River
