1. The day is fine and we are in a hurry P.M. We had a pleasant trip, and were home about 7 P.M. and got ready for prayer meeting. had a good meeting. I do not feel very spry. I had no tea today. Got  $\frac{1}{4}$  bush from Uncle Donald
2. Woman's Meeting at Donald Roy's today gave Bird 10 cts for 1 yd cotton. Gave W. Mulroy 10 15 cts Bird & I were to see N. Swann about the Glen School, drove hurry
3. Washed got 7 yd waist-lining 13. Yeast 10 25
4. Boys went to Lancaster in afternoon. had very heavy rain, sold  $1\frac{1}{2}$  bush potatoes to Fullinwider 75 per bush 1.13. got  $\frac{1}{4}$  yd waist lining 4 cts 4
5. Fine cool day. Bill Morrison & brother & Jane Campbell were here to dinner. Gave Jim 50 cts. Marion & Bird 10 65 65
6. Bird washed I worked in garden got 5.3 cts post-stamps 15 cts Got 10. cream tartar 10 35
7. Had a letter from Far. Sent box to Andy Casin's Birdie engaged in the Glen School \$100 for the rest of the year
8. Mrs Harry & Kate, Jennell Bella & Sarah L.L. Bird Marion & myself, went up to McEgoy's Rapids to wade in the water
9. Pa got home at noon today
10. Boys went to Cornwall today. Far came home in the morning
11. Fine day, a large congregation 5 cts to collection 5
12. Rained all day, made a large washing
13. Bird and I went to Lancaster, she had 10 teeth filled 75 per tooth. 7.50. Marion went to Gore Sunday. Came home today for some clothes and bought 1 pair hose. 18 cts 7-50
14. Rained yesterday and today. Bird got 2 yds check flannel 30 cts per yd 60. forage 6 18 66 9-91
