Hemoptysis.

Subcutaneous injection of 8 minims (0.5 c.c.) of pituitrin nearly always brings relief in average cases. Where first injection fails, give a second, and later if necessary a third, the latter intra-muscularly.—*Citelli*.

Intravenous injections of 0.5 c.c. of pituitrin were followed almost at once by cessation of hemorrhage in 10 out of 12 cases. Where the hemorrhage recurred on succeeding days, the same prompt relief was obtained.—*Rist*.
