

August Monday 8 1927

A very warm muggy day and Dan and I plowed all day with two teams. Pretty heavy going but we had great fun between sets digging out a big stone and burning a pile of brush. Jean and I had a swell dip in the river before we went to bed.

August Thursday 11 1927

Finished the plowing in both fields while Dan worked for a while and then scuffled the turnips with "Egg" in 2 hrs + 5 min. Got grain again in afternoon and shocked up behind the binder.

Tuesday 9

Got Dan started on the disc and then I scuffled the mangels with "Egg" after which Mr. Barker and I killed up the potatoes in both fields. Scuffled 70 rows of corn in upper field with the big maw in afternoon. Jean and I had a short but pleasant walk together after supper.

Friday 12

Done barn of the sheep up after breakfast and then I had a busy time the rest of the day shocking up oats. Finished out the prize piece and I finished shocking after supper. Folks from up home came down for a while and brought Aunt Jean and Walter with them for a visit.

Wednesday 10

Finished cultivating corn in the upper field before dinner. Then after dinner got the binder out and I had my first experience driving a binder on Calvary Farm behind Prince, Della, & Flywheel out piece by piece and six rounds around Oyster oats. Got binder turned at Chocoma and got out up home in the car at night.

Saturday 13

Had a pleasant morning helping get a sheep ready for the show. Helped Jean pick 3 baskets of apples after dinner and then harrowed out of afternoon while Dan & his Dad drew in some show peas and oats. Had a nice time in town at night when Jean & I treated Dad, Mother & Cousin Eva to an ice cream sodas.
