Willie took 1100 lbs corn & horse chop down to Wilsons brought back manure from 7 racks to pile them brought up chop 53cts also half ton shorts \$12.50 of Armstrongs he took 12 doz eggs to Am. on 17 P.M. I sowed 3 more bags oats No. 7 7. 2. Willie harrowed I also finished cultivating 7. 2. I cleaned seed oats A.M. Lobuck had 3 lambs to-day. Mr. Gen over at night to get milk.		33
