

Camden Gore January 1884

Fri Jan 22 cloudy and more moderate, I and John was rails and wood from over the river. Anne has the fever again. Wed Jan 23 cloudy and snow most of the day we was drawing wood and rails from sea over the river again to day.

Thur Jan 24 cloudy part of the day and very cold. I was thrashing out peas. John took Catharine Brock home. Anne a little better. But Richard has the diphtheria.

Fri Jan 25 clear fore part of the day. latter part cloudy. was thrashing out peas this forenoon after noon John and I wear over the river drawing fence blocks and wood.

Sat Jan 26 clear and pleasant cleaning up peas in the fore noon. after noon drawing rails and wood from over the river

Sun Jan 27 cloudy and moderate

Mon Jan 28 cloudy and not quite so cold Anne worse I went for the Dr not doing much else to day

Tue Jan 29 cloudy and soft. took a load of barley and peas to Florence Hill and got chapt. Anne no better had a very bad time of it last night not much better to day.

Camden Gore December 1884

Wed Jan 30th a cloudy rainy foggy day. doing but little to day. Went down to David Brock's, the Grange Supply agent was there. I ordered some groceries. Anne not much better. Thur Jan 31 cloudy and cool. John and I was sawing stove wood. Anne wors this Evening.

Fri Feb 1 cloudy and cool. cutting stove wood part of the day. Anne not much better. Sat Feb 2 cloudy and soft. some snow last night sawing wood part of the day. Anne has the fever again this afternoon.

Sun Feb 3 cloudy and moderate

Mon Feb 4th cloudy and cool attended the Punsterley board this afternoon.

Tue Feb 5th cloudy and soft rain last night and this morning. the snow pretty much gone this Evening. Went for the Dr again this afternoon for Anne. She is very sick.

Wed Feb 6th cloudy and moderate not doing much to day. Benjamin Diffee and wife was here to see Anne who is still quite sick.

Thur Feb 7th cloudy fore part of the day and moderate after noon clear. I was getting in straw out of the stack in to the barn. John was drawing wood. Mahlon Gibson and his wife was here to day.
