

Monday 18th June 1906 fair

J.W. prepared land and started to raise drills for turnips in morning. Chord made sheep crato and fixed stall for paring cattle's feet in. went to town after dinner for Blacksmiths to help us pare feet and. I paid Kenneth McLean ^{collector} for knowle Executors. \$1000 on principal and \$200 intrest. this leaves a bal of \$300 still on our farm I also paid cont \$300⁰⁰

Tuesday 19th June
J.W. raised some drills and started to cross plow for turnips. I sowed about 1 1/2 acres turnips and shipped S.P. Ranges to Jas. D. McGregor also Suffolk ram to Jas Thompson sardin B.C. Downes 65. Ric 945. I pd for Corn at 2 shops \$1⁵² 69¢. 50bu barley at. 50¢ and pd \$5⁰⁰ on it. sent check for \$15⁵⁰ to A.P. Westervelt being freight on bull to McGregor I made up Wills Account today. and find that he owes me \$57 48.58¢ five thousand seven hundred and seventy eight dollars and 58¢
