Cloudy most day raining in P.M. I plowed  
 Perim flow in turnip land Willie worked  
 in garden etc.

Tuesday

Cloudy most day sunny part of P.M.  
 Rain last night to-day some and at night again  
 We took 9 steers B+White, Mike, Ike, Mikee,  
 Dick, Little, Peter, John, White, up to Wilsons  
 to pasture @ \$8 a month for 3 months and \$1 a month  
 for 2 months. We then went down town Willie got  
 at Menis mafe paint 45 buggy paint 75.  
 I went down again in A.M. got Scott shod  
 at Sampkins on mafe 30cts got draw knife from  
 Thomas Mills 10cts mafe brought up load  
 manure from Smalls. In P.M. Willie  
 plowed turnip land Perim flow I wove  
 some of fence. Sold eggs 21 24cts

Rain last night drizzling all A.M.  
 cloudy all day cool. Willie sand prepared  
 buggy in A.M. preparatory to painting. Willie down at mine  
 got sand paper 5 natural brushings<sup>25</sup> he plowed turnip
