- 21 Cold. Cloudy. Thunder and Rain at night. Team 2 Hands on ^{Stone}
- 22 Cold and rainy all day. Stone brushes left. Put on 353 yds on Road
John and team with them all day. Jim Plowing late with Stone 4 days
- 23 (Sunday) Cloudy. Rains from 5 to 8. From Jim. Mary. Even. Maggie. Bear here
- 24 Warm. Cloudy. Stead Turnips. Finishes turning oats. Jim Plowing in 3
- 25 Fine. Jim Plowing in 3. John to Fagus with Shop (909) 1080. Put up Big tile
for spring drilled holes in them Pulling Turnips
- 26 Fine forenoon. Put in 2 tile 3 ft. wide at spring dug up wooden pipe
that was laid on July 24th 1882 it was rotten and cut like cheese
down 2 1/2 years. Pulling Turnip, afternoon till rain came. blowing oats
- 27 2 distinct thunderstorms last night - Showy all day. The first snow of the
Season at night - To Fagus with Shop (Hans) 850 lbs. got pipe for spring
got started to draw in Turnips. A. helping. Mrs. G. here to pick feed.
- 28 Ground white with snow this morning. Showy all day. 2 Teams Plowing ^{4 1/2}
- 29 Frogs too hard to plough. Putting in pipe at spring. to Fagus in 50 tile.
Uncovered spring water works at a cost of \$78.00 made up as follows
Cement 425. 104.3 in tile @ 15.00. 0.92. 79 1/2 ft. 2 in. steel pipe @ 15.00. 15.00. 15.00

- 30 (Sunday) Ground white hard frost. Milder afternoon. A and G to
the farm took Lund jerke up. John Mary to D. S.
- 31 Night - frost then fine drawing Turnips forenoon Pulling after. Jim & tile left
- Nov 1 Misty morning then fine. Pulling and drawing Turnips
- 2 Fine. Turnips all pulled in 3 drawing in 7
- 3 Pretty good day. Pulling Turnips in 7. 3 all in. F. Sheoch took cattle away
- 4 Very hard frost. taking manure out of foundation from Pulling Turnips ^{after}
- 5 Fine. Frosty. Drawing Turnips forenoon Pulling after. Stone here from
- 6 (Sunday) Snow. Snow till noon. Sheoch took cattle away
- 7 Blustery and snowy all day 2 Teams Plowing in 8. To Fagus got
paid for pasture by Sheoch & Scott. Fagus & Bathrick came go grade
on gravel Road but quit to much snow and frost
- 8 More snow. 2 Teams Plowing in 7. Bot. Sheppan Lydown @ \$2.00
helping gas price. Killa Pig. Fixed up feeding cattle. There are
still a lot of Turnips out. G. White. J. Wilson. Rennie round here
