

January Friday 22 1926

Sunday 24

Spent another one of those pleasant Sunday evenings with Jean and the Barker family listening to the radio.

January Monday 25 1926

A busy day for me peddling milk and I was rather tired at night after the late hours the night before.

Tuesday 26

Alut and I saw Grimsby - Paris hockey game. Thirty-five minutes of sevens hockey. Score 3-2 for visitors. Clark of Grimsby knocked "Schaecker" out when he hit him a terrific blow across the face with his stick in the last period.
