my back is very lame & Dehmanns were here Pm
27 Drew 9 loads Oats out of field near Hoovers ^{W. fine clear}
28 Drew 1 load Oats out of field near Hoovers & 3 loads below
garden & 3 loads from field north of B. Co & 1 load
Spring wheat north of graveyard & 1 load spring wheat
out of field back of barn W. fine clear
29 Joe & Flourish helped B. D. thresh Am
finished drawing spring wheat 4 loads Pm. W. clear
my Mother was very poorly today B. C. Administrator
Sacramento today. There was no body present except
our family. She is rather better this evening
30 Sunday at home all day. Joseph ^{W. was here} Shirk's were
here while this Am. W. warm dry clear
31 Joe Dows stones off fallow & began to plow
I didn't do much have lame back went to B. D. Pm
Sept 1 Joe & Flourish Plowed. I chored. W. ^{W. clear} warm clear
2 I & Joe Plowed. W. fine clear
3 I & Joe Plowed. W. drizzly about an hour this morning
& a pretty nice shower after dinner. didn't amount to much
4 Cleaned seed wheat & finished plowing till noon. Joe
sowed the field Pm. I harrowed. W. fine cool

Sept 5 I & John ^{Sept 1874} finished harrowing wheat Joe helped
B. N. thresh W. fine little shower Am. another Pm
Sunday 6 I & Children staid at home with my Mother
Nancy went to Meeting at Wilemanns with A B. & J. D.
wife & some of the Children & Fanny Cobb were here
7 Chored & Cleaned 122 bus seed wheat for John ^{W. fine clear} Mitty Am
Took grain Oats to B. D. Pm Nancy & my Mother
went along to B. N. Joe split sawed wood Pm
I helped while he furrowed wheat Am. W. warm
& Joe split wood I helped awhile. Cleaned 20
bus wheat for John Powell. I let them have
the seed at the price that I get when I sell
the remainder. W. very close sultry & a real
spring wheat sultry this morning. Fulkens were
here at supper helped B. N. fix up hat rack
in Hebron Chapel awhile Pm
9 Harvest lambs & helped Joe finish splitting
wood Am drew in spring wheat bakings Pm
I went to Cherrywood after supper & Joe Cleaned
furrows in wheat. W. very very sultry & dry
10 Thanksgiving day I & Children went to Meeting
at Hebron remarks by B. C. sermon on 5th Book
Moses 8th Chap by R. H. Barker Henry Store's wife
was here after service. W. very very warm. sultry
11 I Nancy & little boys went to Merckham took
Machine Cylinder to Hewet to get Boses filled
got boots measured for boys Am I tried plow
a little in Pea ground back of garden found it
very hard in places drew some old nails for wood
Joe began plowing opposite B. C. goes very well
W. very very hot. Close & dry dry
12 I Plowed in Oat field below garden to be goes well
enough I & little boys made 3 1/2 gals cider at
Pappa Pm. Joe finished plowing opposite B. C.
