made and sowed 15 with New Orleans mirth.
May down town in P.M. got dry goods
at Steels 90 cts due bills. Sulfate of zinc 2
Willie drove down at night took Sophia and May
over to hospital

Raining more or less all day very wet
weather. Mr Bass over in morning went
home about 9 o'clock for rain. We drilled and
sowed 4 more rows before rain. Willie
drove father down in evening he had come
up with card to meet Nellie Paulin at station

he got at Carters shoes & cuff nes 75 cts at Armstrongs
in cafe 4 lbs turnip and 2# Good Jack & Perfecta.
got from Smiths Sundry Agent \$3.00 for straw.
