Raining some in morning cleared off fine sunny day quite warm most spring like day. We started to work land to-day Willie harrowed No 7 SW I plowed some of bottom land A.M. In P.M. Willie harrowed I drove girls down town took to Russells 9 doz eggs @ 15¢ \$1.35 got prices 25 jacket 10.00 paid on it egg money \$1.10 bal on a/c 890 stamps etc 5- meat 60 Mills water can Nicks 50 I got trees from Hall 35¢ to express at station collar mended M&I 30. Perry Perry found dead at station shot apparently by his own hand.

Very warm day mostly sunny. Some dark clouds P.M. some thunder. We cultivated some of No 7 and sowed some Sijaws oats in P.M. started at fence S.W. I disked garden. I had Lucy Ned and Kate in car Willie harrowed with Dan & Jess. Balla down P.M. getting dress fitted at Mess Colclough got at Russells ref. buyeds 45.

Friday

Not so warm to-day cloudy raining at night we got some more oats sowed No 7 Willie worked all day at it. I put in A.M. planting trees in new orchard (see diagram)

Saturday

Heavy rain last night cloudy day some sunshine warm Willie rigged up horse whiffletree A.M. cultivated No 7 horses P.M. I finished planting plum trees got raspberries and some strawberries planted. Willie down town at night got from Jackson for hay in field \$12.25
