Diagnosis of Paralysis Agitans.

New sign, present in the early period of rigidity, when diagnosis is difficult, described. Consist of a "cog-wheel," intermittent resistance felt when examiner grasps wrist with one hand, steadies arm above elbow with the other, and makes rapid flexion and extension of arm. Never found present in other diseases.—*Moyer.*
