The night of Sept 5/6 will never be forgotten by me as it was on that night that Jean made me the happiest day on Earth when she promised to be my bride. Talk about a thrilling evening, it sure was one.

Monday 6

Felt great all day even if I was tired when night rolled around but "no wonder, why shouldnt I feel good?" Traded jobs with Jimmie and spent the afternoon between the plough handles for the first time in ten months. Drove down after hens at Vanatter farm after supper.
