Tue Feb 26th Soft Snow most of the day. I was making a pig trough this fore noon after noon John and I were drawing up wood

Wed Feb 27th Soft Snow most of the day, and disagreeable. Bilton and went up to ~~Georgetown~~ Guelph to John S. Armstrongs to day to buy a young Short horn.

Thur Feb 28th a dreadful cold blustering day. bargained this morning with Mr Armstrong for a young Bull and started for home we took cars at Fergus the trains being behind time being snowed in, we was four hours coming from Fergus to Guelph being stuck fast in the snow got to Guelph at six P. M. didnt get away till eight should have left at 6.10. got to London at 12 P. M.

~~Friday~~ Fri Feb 29th a dreadful cold day. Saw people come into the station this morning with their ears froze. Should have left London this morning at 6.40. but could not get away until near 11 got home about 3 P. M. find Anne still very sick had hoped to find her much better all well other ways

Camden Gore March 1884
Sat March 1st cloudy and cool. was carrying straw into the old barn this after noon fore noon was sawing stove wood.

Sun Mar 2nd clear and cool.
Mon Mar 3rd cloudy Snow Squalls and cold put up a load of grain to get chopt this fore noon after took it of Florence Mill and got it choptth Anne not much better.

Tue Mar 4th clear a pleasant winter day. this fore noon I was filing the crosscut saw after noon was over the river making a pig trough.

Wed Mar 5th clear and warm. Went with J. H. Snary to Thamesville for the young Bull we bough from John S. Armstrong back of Guelph

Thu Mar 6th cloudy and moderate. went to Dresden to Mill the roads quite sloppy this evening
Fri Mar 7th cloudy and cool. Some Snow last night was carrying a little straw in the old barn John went for the Dr for Anne again this after noon she is very poorly. Benjamin Tiffin was here this after noon to see Anne

Sat Mar 8th cloudy and Snow most of the day not doing much to day Anne no better

Sun Mar 9th cloudy and Snow
Mon Mar 10th cloudy and moderate. we was sawing and splitting stove wood at the house. we think Anne is a little better
